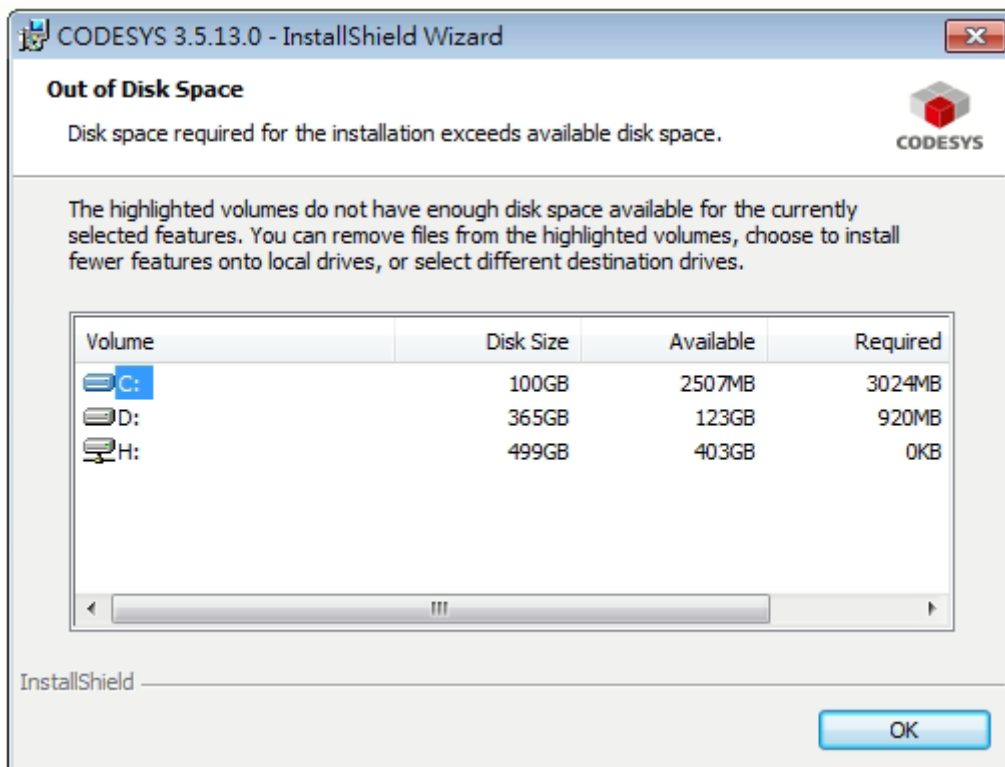

■ **Problem Description & Architecture:**

Sometimes users want to install CODESYS IDE into another disk except for disk C. However, if space of disk C is not enough, the IDE installer will shows the warning message as below.



■ **Brief Solution - Step by Step:**

Yes, IDE could install on other disk, but some files still need to install in disk C (more than 2GB). The main reason showed below is from the CODESYS:

The setup deploys files to various locations during installation process. One location is on disk C: in ProgramData. This place hosts the repositories (libraries, devices, visual elements, visual styles) and has a size of more than 2GB.

This is the reason why the message is shown although CODESYS is installed on drive D:

Unfortunately, the location of the repositories cannot be influenced during the installation process.
