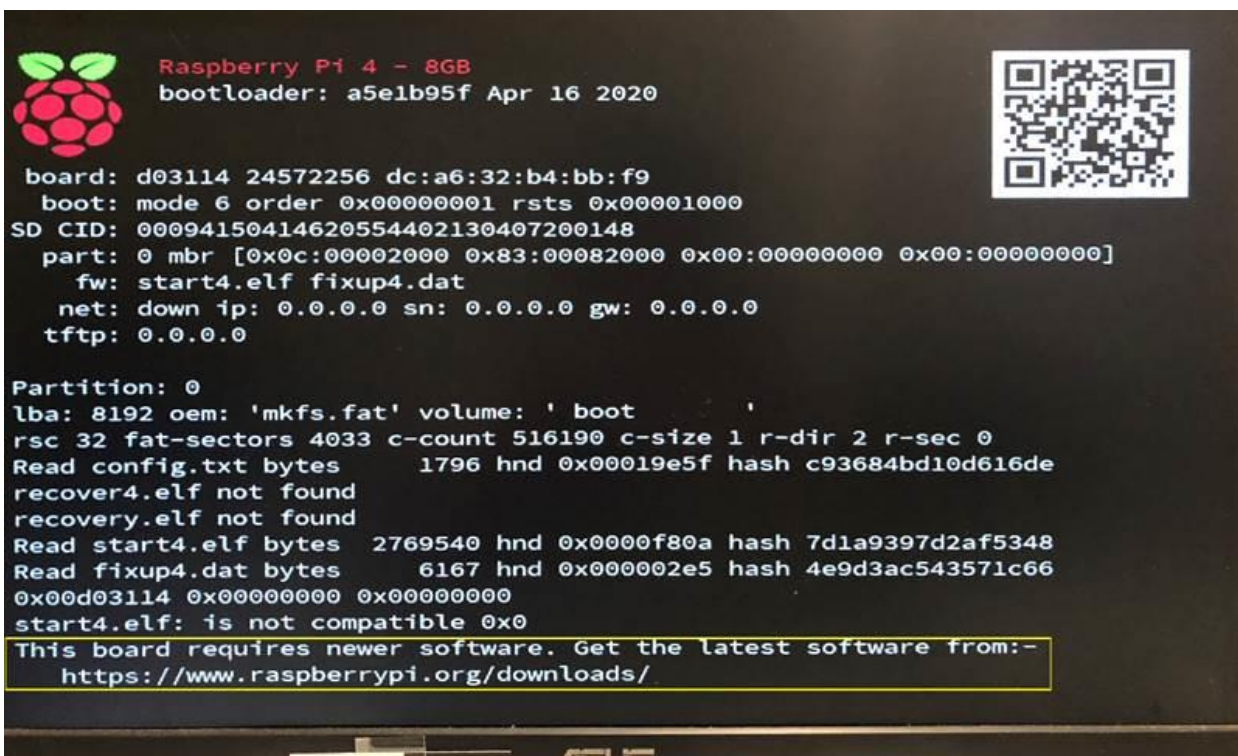

■ **Problem Description:**

When user install AdvRaspbian OS 20190930 with Raspberry Pi 4 4GB/8GB, user may encounter the problem of Pi 4 mainboard requires newer software, as shown below



**■ Brief Solution:**

User can download official Raspberry Pi OS via this link:

<https://www.raspberrypi.org/downloads/raspberry-pi-os/>

Alternatively, user can use Raspberry Pi Imager to install Raspberry Pi OS to an SD card ready to use with your Raspberry Pi.

When UNO-220 boot with official Raspberry Pi OS, they can install driver by following the steps below:

```
$ chmod 777 /etc/apt/sources.list
```

Append the following in /etc/apt/sources.list on your Pi 4.

```
deb [trusted=yes] https://advantechralph.github.io/uno-220/dpkg/ /
```

Run apt-get update

```
$ sudo apt-get update
```

Install packages.

```
$ sudo apt-get install uno220config uno220rtc uno220gpio uno220uart
```

Reboot your Pi 4 and test IO.

```
$ sudo systemctl reboot
```
