Introduction

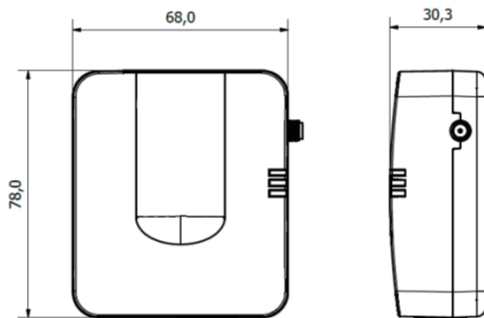
The USM-D62 is the gateway device between the LEO-D manager server and USM-D64 hub devices that together form the LEO-D ePaper System. Communication with the Web Portal is via a hard wired 10/100 BaseT Ethernet Cat5E cable interface and communications with the system hardware devices utilize a unique wireless protocol (Proprietary Sub-1GHz ISM band), turned to optimize power consumption and network efficiency.

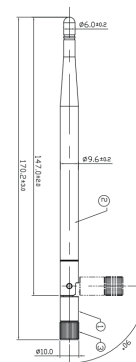
